



#### **Tennessee Gas Prices Among Lowest in the Nation**



Tennessee now ranks third in the nation for the lowest average gas prices, according to AAA. The current statewide average is \$2.70 per gallon—four cents lower than a month ago and 33 cents below the average at this time last year.

Only Oklahoma (\$2.69) and Mississippi (\$2.63) have cheaper averages.

"Tennessee's average gas price is holding steady again this week with unseasonably low gas prices," said Stephanie Milani, public affairs director for AAA – The Auto Club Group. "Demand for gasoline is helping to keep gas prices

low to begin the summer driving season. It's giving those who are traveling a nice savings in their road trip budget."

AAA reports that Knoxville drivers are paying around \$2.66 per gallon, which is slightly cheaper than Nashville (\$2.74) and Memphis (\$2.72), but a bit higher than Chattanooga's \$2.62 average.

Among East Tennessee counties, Rhea County currently has the lowest average at \$2.56 per gallon, while McMinn County matches the state average at \$2.70.




