Box Truck Overturns on I-75, Two Sustain Minor Injuries



A box truck hauling restaurant supplies overturned on Interstate 75 Tuesday evening, causing a significant traffic disruption and a lengthy cleanup effort.

The incident occurred around 5:00 p.m. on June 10, when a 26foot box truck traveling north in the left lane veered toward the median near Exit 56. The driver overcorrected, causing the vehicle to flip onto its side and come to rest across the right lane and partially onto the exit ramp.

Two people were inside the truck at the time of the crash. Both sustained minor injuries but declined transport by EMS.

Emergency crews from Niota Rural Fire Department, Clearwater Rural Fire Department, AMR Ambulance, and the Tennessee Highway Patrol responded to the scene. David Prater of Niota Rural Fire was in command of the response. Cleanup took several hours as crews worked to clear the roadway and remove the overturned vehicle.



Small Earthquake Recorded Near Tellico Plains

A minor earthquake was recorded late Tuesday night in East Tennessee, according to a preliminary report from the U.S. Geological Survey.

Morning Fax

The magnitude 1.8 quake occurred at 10:20 p.m. local time on June 10. The epicenter was located approximately 8.4 miles east-southeast of Tellico Plains, at a depth of 7 kilometers.

The tremor was also measured at about 26 miles east-southeast of Athens, 30.5 miles south-southwest of Maryville, and roughly 110 miles north of Atlanta, Georgia. No damage or injuries have been reported. The event was recorded by the Southeast U.S. Seismic Network, with data provided in part by the University of Memphis.
