#### Retired Cleveland State Nurse Educator Brings "Hope" to West Africa

Retired Cleveland State nursing instructor Nancy Thomas is continuing her mission to elevate the nursing profession by supporting *Espoir*, a medical training school in Chinguetti, Mauritania. With more than 40 years of nursing experience, including 16 years teaching at Cleveland State, Thomas began traveling to the West African town in 2023 after learning about the school through a friend. Founded by Dr. Amanda Beattie to train doctors and nurses in a medically underserved region, *Espoir* now benefits from Thomas's donated lesson plans, books, and equipment—including a maternity simulator no longer used at the college.

Despite limited technology and instruction in English for French- and Arabic-speaking students, the school graduated its first three nurses this spring. Thomas taught classes during her January visit and is now helping design a pre-nursing course to prepare incoming students. She plans to return in December as the school works to secure formal government approval and continue addressing the area's healthcare shortage—living out the Florence Nightingale Pledge by lifting up the next generation of nurses, one student at a time.


# Jim's Mattress & More opens new location in Athens

Deputy Logan Brooks and Detective Cody Day of the Polk County Sheriff's Office worked the case and found that Roy B. Perdew Jr. was the suspect in the theft. Roy B. Perdew Jr. has been apprehended on charges of Theft of Property (Over \$10,000) and Vandalism (Over \$2,500) and is currently being held on a "no bond" at the Polk County Jail.
