Athens Racers on the National Stage for Soap Box Derby Championship Radio Coverage All Week on WYXI FM 94.5 / AM 1390

Local champions Arliss Douglas (Super Stock Division) and Titus Millsaps (Stock Division) earned their tickets to Akron after winning their divisions at the Athens Soap Box Derby on May 31. 

Unattended Fire Destroys Truck on County Road 550



A 2004 Chevy Silverado was destroyed by fire Saturday night on County Road 550, after an attempt to start the vehicle ended in flames.

According to the owner, the truck had not been

started since March 2024. Around 10 p.m., he and several friends tried to get it running but were unsuccessful. During the process, a piece of burning paper accidentally fell into the truck bed, which contained trash. The fire spread rapidly.

Attempts to extinguish the flames were hampered by a short water hose, and the fire quickly consumed the vehicle. The truck was deemed a total loss.

Firefighters from Englewood Rural Fire Department and Etowah Rural Fire Department responded to the scene.

Fire Destroys Corn Crib, Threatens Chicken Coop in Etowah



A corn crib was destroyed in a fire early Sunday morning on County Road 804 after it collapsed into smoldering embers from a previous burn.


The incident occurred around 7:30 a.m., while the property owner was in the process of de-

molishing the corn crib. During the teardown, the structure shifted and fell into the remains of a recent fire that still contained hot embers, igniting the wooden structure. Flames quickly spread and threatened a nearby chicken coop, prompting a multi-agency response. Etowah Rural Fire, Claxton Fire, and Englewood Rural Fire all responded to the scene, with Etowah Rural Fire Captain Ryland Hearn in command.

Crews worked to contain the blaze and protect nearby structures. The corn crib was a total loss.

Vehicle Fire on Eastanaula Road Sparks Emergency Response



A 2000 Chevy Blazer was destroyed by fire Sunday evening on Eastanaula Road after a cigarette accidentally ignited a blaze inside the vehicle.

The fire was reported around 6 p.m., after the owner, who was smoking inside the vehicle, attempted to extinguish her cigarette in the ashtray. The cigarette sparked a fire, and while trying to put it out and remove it from the vehicle, it fell onto the floorboard, quickly igniting the interior. Christianburg Fire Department requested mutual aid, and Englewood Rural Fire Department responded alongside the Monroe County Sheriff's Department. Emergency crews were able to extinguish the fire, but the vehicle was a total loss.
