### Fire Destroys Home on Washington Avenue in Etowah



The Etowah City Fire Department responded to a house fire Wednesday around 1:30 p.m. on Washington Avenue in Etowah. When crews arrived, flames were visible at the front of the home.

Mutual aid was requested from Etowah Rural and Englewood Rural Fire Departments. Officials believe the fire originated at the front of the house, which sustained heavy fire and smoke damage. Fortunately, no one was home at the time.

Other responding agencies included Etowah City Police, McMinn County Hazmat Air Support, AMR, and Etowah Utilities Board. Etowah City Fire Chief Adam Hafley was in command of the scene.

#### Cleveland State Grad Reinvents Career After 25 Years at Coca-Cola

After more than two decades working at Coca-Cola United, Polk County native Jeff "Cubby" Culberson made a life-changing decision to return to school and pursue a new career path. Now 50, Culberson recently completed Cleveland State Community College's mechatronics certificate program and is working as a Maintenance Technician at the same company where he spent much of his career.

Culberson, who started at Coca-Cola United in 1995, had previously taken classes at Cleveland State after high school but said he wasn't ready to take them seriously. Decades later, with encouragement from a manager and access to tuition-free classes through Tennessee Reconnect, he enrolled again—this time balancing night shifts with college coursework.

The hands-on training in the mechatronics program mirrored his day-to-day responsibilities, including work with motors, conveyors, and production lines. Culberson credits the program's instructors for helping him gain both the technical knowledge and confidence to grow professionally. Graduating in May 2024, Culberson said returning to school later in life was a challenge, but one he's proud to have completed. His story reflects the impact of adult education opportunities like Tennessee Reconnect, which allows qualifying adults to attend community college tuition-free.
