

Big Changes Ahead for Simmons Bank in Athens



Two of the most iconic buildings in Athens will be vacated soon. The first is the former Citizens National Bank building that was constructed in the early 1960's, located at the corner of Park Street and South White Street in downtown Athens (top photo). The second building will be the former corporate headquarters of Goody's Family Clothing and Warehouse, located on South Congress Parkway (middle photo). The for-



mer "Goody's" building became the Financial Center for Citizens National Bank, when Goody's moved their headquarters to Knoxville in the 1990's. Both of the Athens buildings were purchased by Simmons Bank during their merger with Citizens National Bank in 2016. The downtown building and the financial center building will be consolidated into one building, which is the former First National Bank Building at the corner of Hill Street and West Washington Avenue in downtown Athens (bottom photo). Renovations of the old FNB building are already underway and sources say that the goal is to move all of the Simmons Bank Athens personnel and services to the new location late this year or in early 2026.


