Fire Destroys Building in Etowah



Firefighters battled a blaze on County Road 798 in Etowah late Monday morning after receiving reports around 11:30 a.m. The structure was already heavily engulfed in flames when crews arrived and was declared a total loss.

Fire personnel remained on the scene for nearly four hours. Responding agencies included Madisonville City Fire Dept., West Polk Fire, and Athens Rural Fire. The Etowah Utilities Board also responded to cut off utility services.

Because the homeowner resides out of state, the McMinn County Sheriff's Department and the TBI Arson and Bomb **Unit** were contacted to investigate the cause of the fire.

Etowah Rural Fire Chief Adam Hafley was in command of the scene.


Hughes Retirement Group joins Athens Chamber of Commerce

The U.S. Geological Survey recorded a magnitude 1.9 earthquake late Wednesday morning between Athens and Sweetwater.

The quake struck at 10:09 a.m. lo-

cal time on August 27, 2025, about 3.4 miles southsouthwest of Sweetwater and 10 miles northeast of Athens, at a depth of roughly 5 miles. No damage or injuries were reported.
