

### Minor Injuries Reported After Two-Vehicle Crash on Highway 68



A two-vehicle crash Monday evening on Highway 68 at County Road 342 in McMinn County left both vehicles damaged but resulted in only minor injuries.

According to reports, the accident occurred around 5 p.m. when a 2025 Nissan Versa traveling south struck the passenger side of a 1995 Chevy Blazer that was turning onto County Road 342. The impact caused the Blazer to roll onto its side. Occupants of the vehicle kicked out

the windshield to escape and declined medical treatment from EMS at the scene.

Responding agencies included North McMinn Fire, Niota Rural Fire, AMR, and the Tennessee Highway Patrol. Stephen Capua with North McMinn Fire was in command of the scene, and Trooper Logan Ballew is investigating the crash.
