# Athens Announces Start of 2025 Leaf Vacuum Season



The City of Athens Public Works Department has announced that its annual Leaf Vacuum Season will begin Monday, October 27, 2025, at 7 a.m. Crews will start collecting loose leaves across the city, operating in designated zones throughout the season.

Residents are asked to rake their leaves three to five feet from the edge of the road for pickup. Leaves should **not** be placed in the street, drainage ditches, or on sidewalks, as this can create safety hazards and clog storm drains, potentially leading to flooding. In neighborhoods with sidewalks, leaves should be placed behind them for collection.

Officials remind residents not to pile leaves around or behind obstacles such as mailboxes, fences, vehicles, trees, or utility covers. Doing so can damage the city's vacuum equipment and delay service. Leaf piles placed on water meter lids, manhole covers, or sewer caps will not be collected.

Public Works crews will follow a set zone rotation rather than taking call-in requests. Once all zones are completed, crews will restart the rotation and make multiple passes through the city. Updates on which zones are currently being serviced can be found on the city's website at www.athenstn.gov/public-works.

Leaf pickup timing may vary due to weather or the volume of leaves in each area. The department expects to complete two full rounds of collection, with a third and final run announced later in the season. Leaf vacuum operations typically continue through February, depending on weather conditions.

As an alternative, residents can bag their leaves for faster pickup during the city's regular bi-weekly brush and junk routes. Leaves can also be mulched or composted for lawn and garden use.



# **Obituaries**


