

Madisonville Man Killed After Confrontation Over Dog Shooting; Neighbor Charged With Murder



A Madisonville man was shot and killed early Friday morning following a confrontation with a neighbor who had allegedly entered his home and killed his dog, according to the Monroe County Sheriff's Office.

Deputies were dispatched around 12:30 a.m. to the 800 block of Big Creek Road, where they found Adam Ray McGill deceased on the side of the roadway. Investigators say McGill had collapsed while attempting to return home after confronting his neighbor, Gregory Scott Williams, about the earlier incident.

A female witness reported that Williams had gone into the McGill residence while no one was home and shot her dog as it lay in its bed. Detectives say McGill then went to Williams' home, where the fatal encounter occurred. Williams later admitted to firing a .22-caliber rifle, and deputies recovered the weapon during a search of his residence.

Authorities allege Williams shot the dog because it had acted aggressively toward his wife earlier in the day.

Williams has been charged with first-degree murder, aggravated burglary and aggravated animal cruelty. He is being held in the Monroe County Jail without bond.

The sheriff's office extended condolences to McGill's family and said the investigation remains active. Additional information will be released as it becomes available.
