Crash Into Gas Line Forces Road Closure on W. Willson Street in Niota

Okay to distribute

(with attribution)



Authorities temporarily shut down a section of West Willson Street Friday afternoon after a vehicle struck a major gas line in the 800 block of the roadway near Sugar Shack.

The incident occurred around 4 p.m. when a 2008 Nissan Altima, driven by a 40-year-old male, was traveling southbound and left the roadway, entering a culvert before returning to the road and striking a six-inch gas line. First responders from Niota Fire, Athens Fire, Clearwater Fire, and the McMinn County Sheriff's Office responded and immediately closed the highway as a safety precaution. Crews from the Athens Utility Board worked quickly to shut off the gas and secure the scene after a significant leak was reported. AMR evaluated the driver at the scene, and no injuries were reported. The driver was later transported to the Justice Center by the Tennessee Highway Patrol. Athens Fire Chief Chuck Burris was in command of the scene, and THP Trooper Chandler Lamar is leading the investigation.

A single-vehicle crash was reported Thursday night around 8:30 p.m. on County Road 326 involving a 2018 Ford F-150.

Authorities say the truck veered off the roadway, entered a ditch, and struck a tree. The 30-year-old female driver, who was the sole occupant, was evaluated at the scene by AMR and reported no injuries.

Niota Rural Fire, North McMinn Fire, AMR, and the McMinn County Sheriff's Office responded to the incident. Chad Gates was in command of the scene, and no fire was reported. Tennessee Highway Patrol Trooper Scott Freeman investigated the crash.

The celebration will also include live music, food concessions, splash pad access, and other family-friendly activities.

The evening will conclude with a 20-minute combined fireworks and drone display, designed to honor the nation's semiquincentennial while continuing Athens' tradition of hosting a community-centered holiday event.
