Athens Area Council for the Arts (AACA) is pleased to welcome Kyshona Armstrong, Damien Horne, and Joy Clark on Friday, February 6 at 7:00 PM at The Arts Center's Sue E. Trotter Black Box Theater.

Kyshona Armstrong returns to close the 2025-26 Black Box Concert Series with Songwriter's Night with Kyshona. This show is an intimate evening with singer-songwriters sharing original music, curated by Kyshona Armstrong. Kyshona is an artist ignited by untold stories, and the capacity of those stories to thread connections in every community. With the background of a licensed music therapist, the curiosity of a writer, the patience of a friend, the vision of a social entrepreneur, the resolve of an activist, and the voice of a singer - Kyshona is unrelenting in her pursuit for the healing power of song. She lends her voice and music to those that feel they have been lost, silenced, forgotten or alone. Joining Kyshona are singer songwriters Damien Horne and Joy Clark.

Louisiana born-and-raised singer-songwriter and guitarist Joy Clark is charting her own path with her debut album *Tell it to the Wind*. As the youngest of five children born into a tight-knit, deeply religious family just outside of New Orleans, her release is both a declaration of her independence and a love letter to the traditions that shaped her.

Damien Horne began performing at a young age growing up in Hickory, North Carolina. After high school graduation, Damien took a Greyhound bus to Los Angeles chasing his entertainment dreams.

After becoming homeless, Damien returned to North Carolina where he formed the band Stellar Tree and made the move to Nashville. Performing on the streets at night led Damien to be discovered by country star John Rich who invited him to join the MuzikMafia through which Damien was able to secure a publishing deal and tour nationally with such artists as Dwight Yoakum, Kid Rock, and John Legend.
