### Athens City Council to Discuss Downtown Brewery Zoning, Grants at Jan. 12 Work Session



The Athens City Council will hold a work session Monday, Jan. 12, at 5 p.m. in the City Hall Conference Room to discuss a wide range of policy, financial, and planning matters, including potential zoning changes that could allow breweries downtown.

A key topic will be the possible amendment of city zoning regulations to permit brewpubs, microbreweries, tap-rooms, and similar establishments in the B-2 Central Business District and B-3 Intensive Business District. The discussion follows an inquiry from an established Knoxville brewery interested in opening a production brewery and taproom in downtown Athens. Current zoning restricts alcohol manufacturing to heavy industrial districts, effectively excluding downtown locations.


Council members will also hear a presentation from Matt Altobell, executive director of the Tennessee Craft Brewers Guild, as part of the discussion on brewery-related zoning.

Additional items on the agenda include the continuation of HHM as city auditors for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026; resolutions declaring Athens Flood Awareness Week; and authorizing grant applications related to historical projects, transportation improvements, and emergency rescue equipment.

Other discussion items include proposed fee changes for baseball and softball field rentals, awarding a bid to renovate the Regional Park house into Parks and Recreation offices, citizen comment rules, and review of a city judge application.

Mayor and councilmember items will address recycling pickup options, the condition of City Hall, and a proposed graffiti ordinance. The session will also include appointments to boards and committees, including the Athens Municipal Regional Planning Commission.

No formal votes are held during the work session, but discussions will help shape future council actions.

## Series of Small Earthquakes Recorded Near Etowah and Athens



A series of minor earthquakes were recorded in McMinn County and surrounding areas on Friday, Jan. 9, 2026, according to preliminary data from the U.S. Geological Survey and the Southeast U.S. Seismic Network.

The seismic activity included three small earthquakes ranging in magnitude from 1.9 to 2.0. Two of the events, both measuring magnitude 1.9, were centered approximately 4.4 miles east-northeast of Etowah and about 10 to 11 miles southeast of Athens, occurring at approximately 5:24 a.m. and 1:40 p.m. local time. A third earthquake, measuring magnitude 2.0, was recorded later that night at approximately 10:51 p.m., with an epicenter about 8.8 miles southeast of Etowah and 17.6 miles southeast of Athens.

All three earthquakes occurred at depths ranging from 11 to 17 kilometers. No damage or injuries were reported, and such low-magnitude earthquakes are typically not felt or cause minimal ground shaking.

The reports are considered preliminary and subject to revision as additional data is analyzed.

## City of Athens Announces Second Round of Leaf Vacuum Season

The City of Athens Public Works Department will begin the second round of its Leaf Vacuum Season on Wednesday, Jan. 14, 2026.

Residents wishing to have leaves collected are asked to rake them three to five feet from the edge of the roadway. Leaves should not be placed in streets, drainage ditches, or on sidewalks, as this can create safety hazards and clog storm drains, potentially leading to flooding. In areas with sidewalks, leaves should be placed behind the sidewalk for collection.

Public Works officials also caution residents not to place leaves on or around obstacles such as mailboxes, trees, fences, poles, yard decorations, water meter lids, or vehicles. Leaf piles near obstructions will not be collected to prevent damage to property or equipment.

Residents can find out which zone leaf crews are currently servicing by calling 423-744-2745 or visiting the Public Works section of the city's website. A leaf collection map is also available online.

For quicker service, residents are encouraged to bag leaves for pickup on regular junk routes. Mulching leaves with a lawn mower or composting them for use in gardens and flowerbeds are also recommended alternatives.

### Tennessee Unemployment Drops as Workforce Grows Ahead of Holidays

Tennessee entered the 2025 holiday season with a stronger workforce than the year before, according to new data from the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development. The state's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate fell to 3.6% in November 2025, down one-tenth of a percentage point from November 2024.

Nonfarm employment increased by 7,600 jobs over the month, led by gains in private education and health services, other services, and administrative and support services. Compared to a year earlier, Tennessee added 34,800 nonfarm jobs, with the largest increases in professional and business services, trade, transportation and utilities, and leisure and hospitality.

Most counties reported low unemployment, with 87 of the state's 95 counties below 5%. Williamson County had the lowest rate at 2.9%, while Perry County recorded the highest at 6%. Pickett, Meigs, and Grundy counties followed with the next highest jobless rates.
