Cleveland State Nursing Graduates Earn 100% Pass Rate on National Exam

Cleveland State Community College's Nursing Program is celebrating an impressive milestone as its 2025 spring

Cleveland State Community College's Nursing Program is graduates achieved a 100% pass rate on the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX). The achievement includes students from both the Day Sequence and LPN to

RN Bridge Sequence programs.

The NCLEX is a national exam required for nursing graduates to obtain licensure and ensure they are prepared to safely and effectively practice as registered nurses. The Tennessee State Board of Nursing requires accredited programs to maintain at least an 80% pass rate for first-time test takers, making Cleveland State's results especially noteworthy.

Cleveland State's Associate of Applied Science degree in Nursing prepares students for employment as registered nurses in hospitals, clinics, and other healthcare settings. The two-year program offers both day and evening classes, with over 40 students currently enrolled in the day sequence and 25 in the evening sequence. The college also offers a spring bridge program for licensed practical nurses seeking to advance their careers.

Students gain hands-on experience through classroom instruction, skills training, and clinical rotations at local healthcare facilities, supported by the college's state-of-the-art simulation lab.

Combine Fire Burns Cornfield in Etowah Sunday Afternoon



A farm equipment fire in Etowah Sunday afternoon destroyed a combine and scorched about an acre of a cornfield before being brought under control by local fire crews.

The blaze occurred around 3:30 p.m. near the intersection of County Roads 789 and 785, when a 2008 International Harvester combine caught fire due to a defective ball bearing, according to officials.

Firefighters from the Etowah Rural Fire Department, Claxton Fire Department, and Englewood Rural Fire Department responded to the scene. Lt. Austin Hancock with Etowah Rural Fire was in command of operations.

No injuries were reported, and firefighters were able to prevent the flames from spreading further into the field.

Volunteer Fire Departments Can Apply for State Wildland Firefighting Grants

The Tennessee Department of Agriculture Division of Forestry is now accepting applications for the 2025 Volunteer Fire Assistance (VFA) program through October 31, 2025. The program provides wildland fire suppression kits to help strengthen volunteer fire departments' firefighting capabilities.

Last year, the Division awarded \$165,000 in federal funds to supply 85 volunteer fire departments across Tennessee with kits valued at about \$3,000 each, which include protective gear, tools, and equipment. The 2025 kits will be distributed in February 2026.

Eligible departments must serve communities with populations under 10,000 and have a current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Division of Forestry dated after June 30, 2019.


