Knight Confirmed as McMinn County Director of Schools



The McMinn County Board of Education has officially appointed Melasawn Knight as the new Director of Schools, voting unanimously to confirm her during a called meeting earlier this week.

Board members present voted 9-0 to name Knight to the position, ending her tenure as interim director and making her the permanent leader of the county school system.

Knight was first named interim Director of Schools following the passing of former Director Julie Goodin. At the time, Knight served as the system's Federal Programs Supervisor. The board later formalized that appointment in November, approving a contract that allowed Knight to serve as interim director through June 1, 2026 at the same salary Goodin had received. That vote was also unanimous. During earlier discussions, board members were tasked with outlining a process to hire a permanent director, and it was publicly acknowledged that Knight would be a candidate.

Timing became a key issue, as 2026 is an election year with half of the school board seats on the ballot. Board Chairman Jonathan Pierce noted that state law prohibits the hiring of a director within 45 days before or after an election, meaning a decision would need to be made well ahead of the August 2026 election if the current board were to act.

Support for Knight was evident during those earlier meetings, when multiple school system employees stood to verbally endorse her. The process concluded this week with the board's unanimous confirmation. Following the vote, Board Chairman Jonathan Pierce and Knight signed her contract, officially marking the transition. One Injured in I-75 Crash Near Niota Exit



A single-vehicle crash Tuesday night sent one man to the hospital after a van left the roadway on Interstate 75 near Niota.

The accident occurred around 8 p.m. when a Mercedes van traveling northbound on I-75 ran off the right-hand shoulder just before the Niota exit. The driver, a 29-year-old male from Houston, Texas, was the sole occupant of the vehicle.

He was treated at the scene and transported by AMR ambulance to Sweetwater Emergency Room. His condition was not immediately released.

Niota Fire Department responded to the scene, with Christian Willis serving as incident commander. Additional assistance was provided by Athens Rural Fire Department, Clearwater Fire Department, and AMR. The Tennessee Highway Patrol is investigating the crash. Trooper DJ Taylor is leading the investigation.

Starr Regional Medical Center Recognizes Nurses for Clinical Ladder Achievement





